She waits and waits for her eggs to hatch.

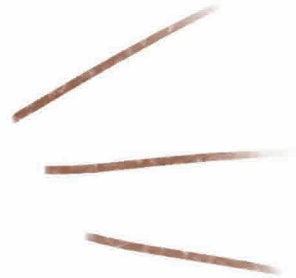


Mother Hen sits on

Mother Hen answers.



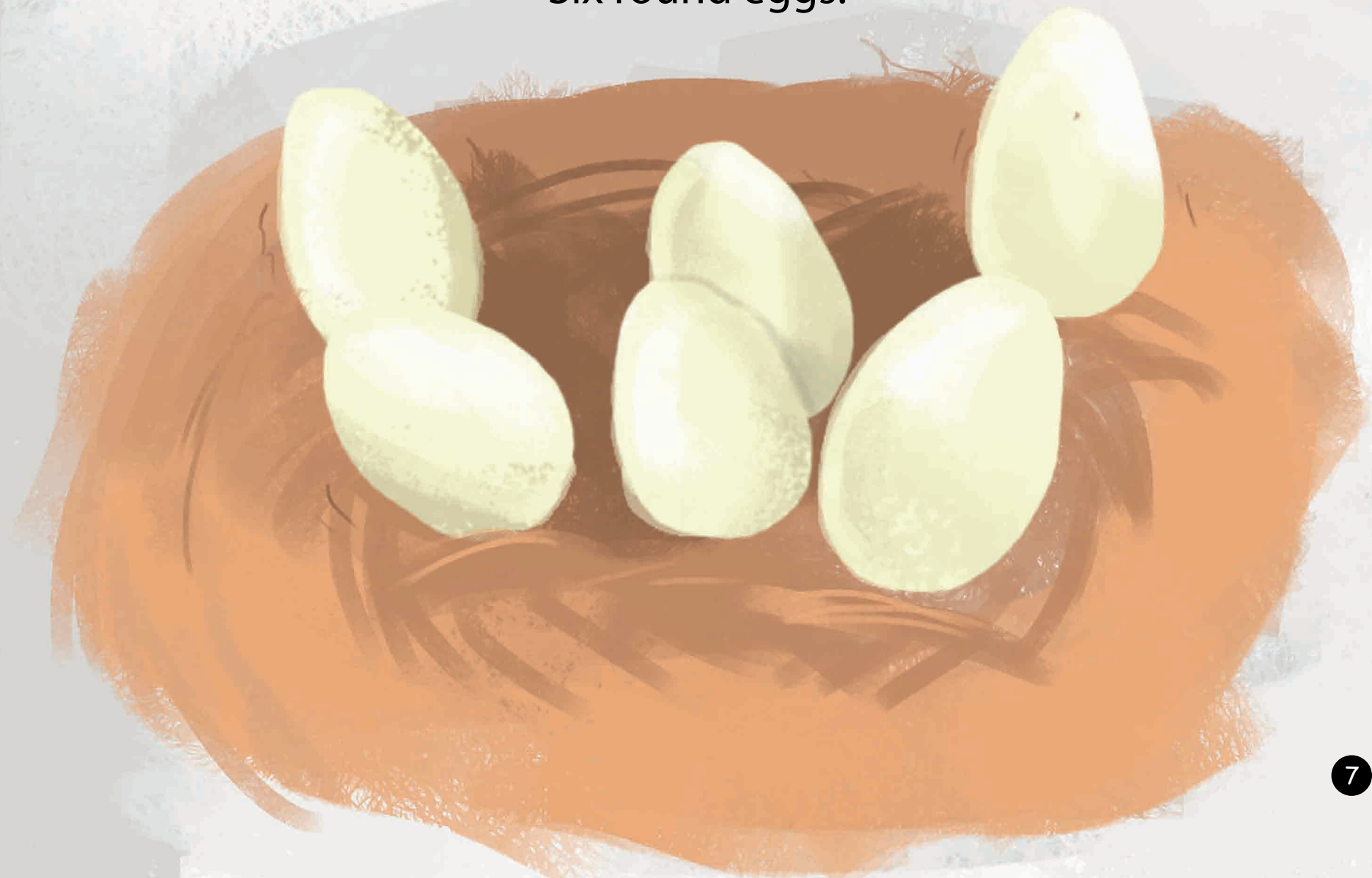
One, two, three,

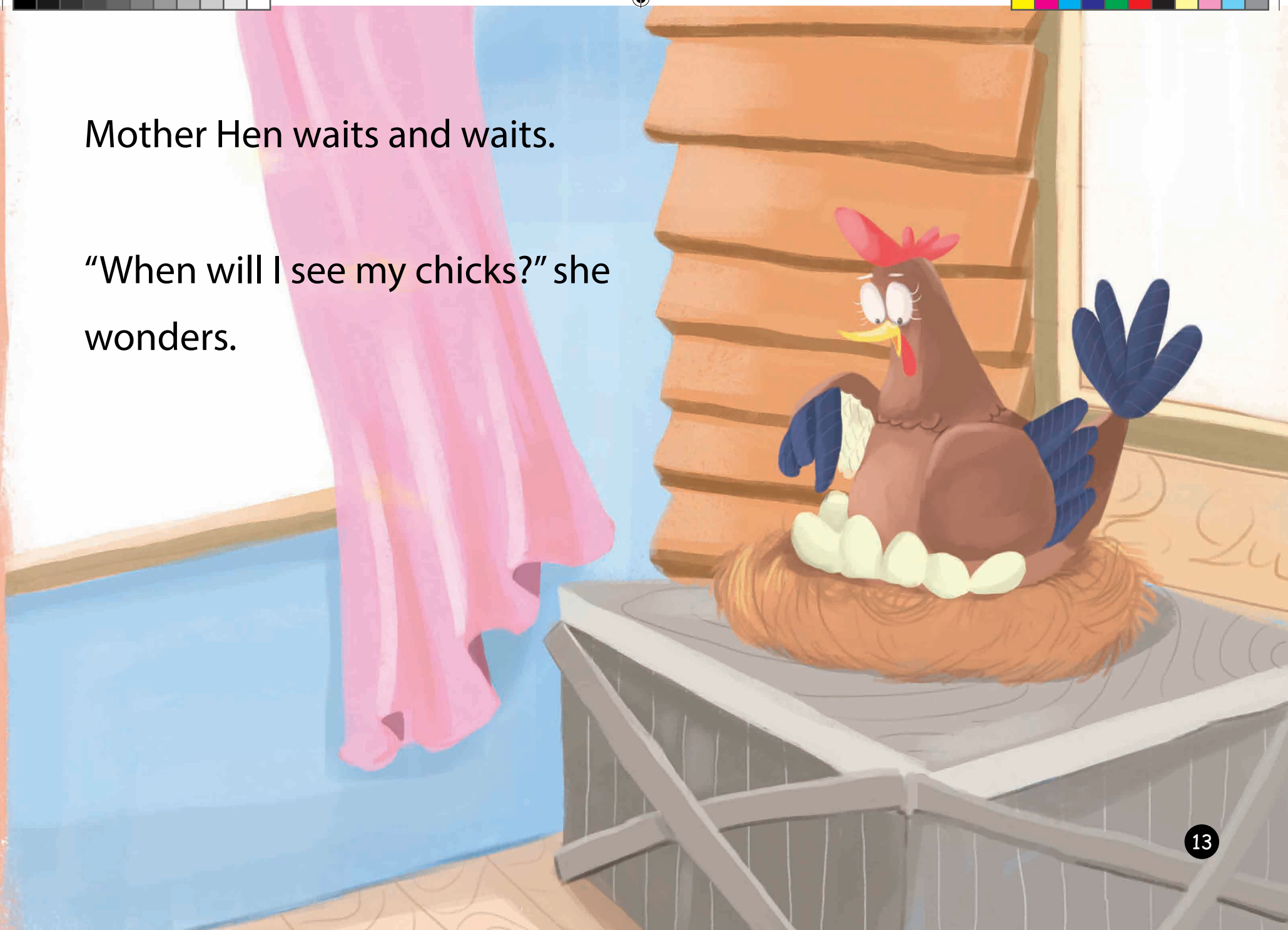






Mother Hen waits and waits.
