answers Porcupine.



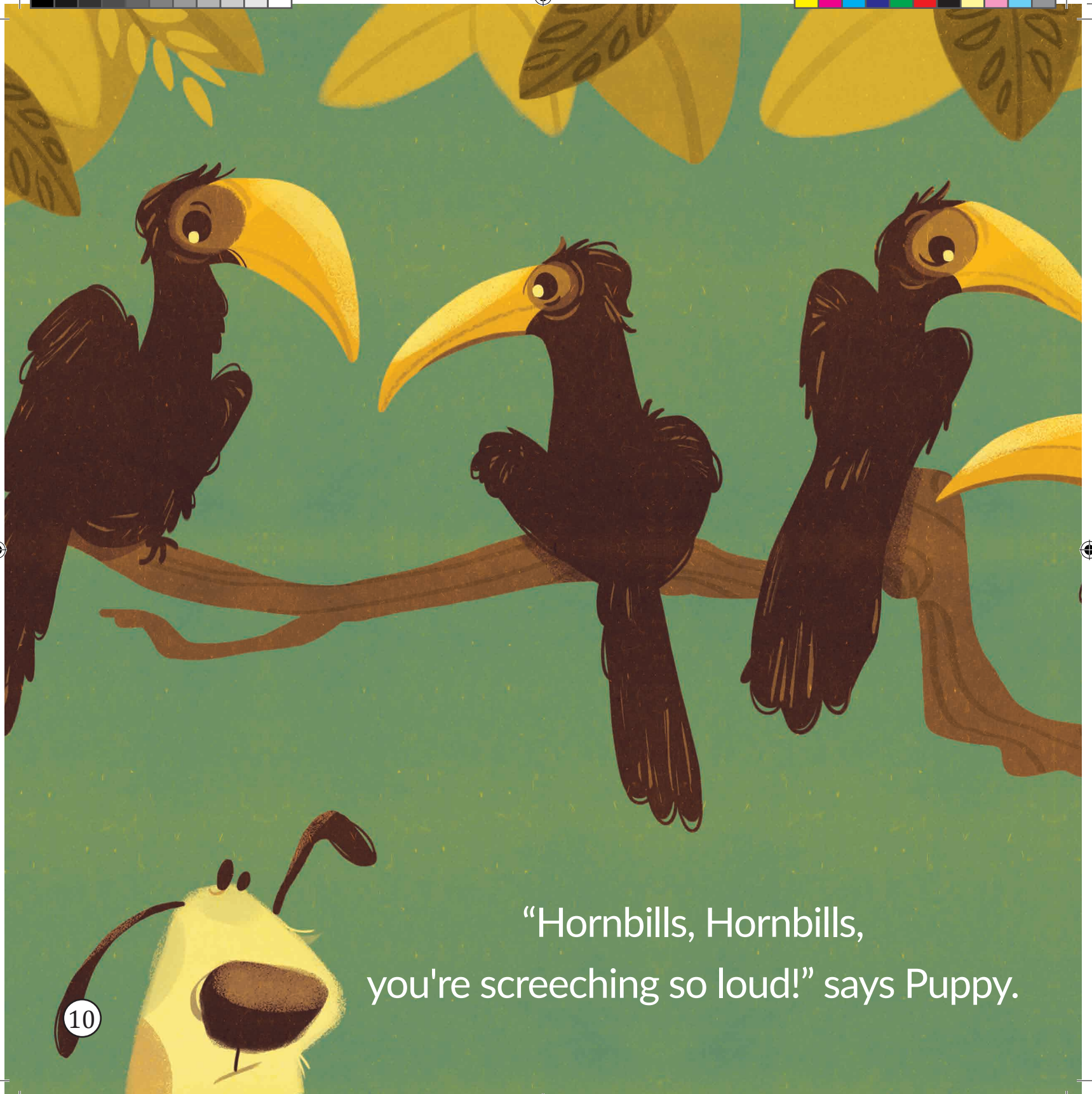
“Woodpecker, Woodpecker,

answer the Hornbills






“Hummingbirds, hummingbirds,
